

NOTICE TO THE BAR

April 14, 2020

The CARES Act contains provisions which allow debtor to seek an extension of the plan term if the Court entered an order confirming the plan prior to March 27, 2020 (Enactment date).

Under the CARES Act, a debtor may seek an extension of a plan confirmed prior to March 27, 2020 if debtor is able to demonstrate that he/she has experienced a change in circumstances as a result of the COVID -19 Pandemic.

If a debtor seeks an extension of the plan pursuant to the CARES Act debtor should file a modified plan and append to the plan a Certification in Support of COVID-19 Modification of Plan.
